Summary

Microsoft announced the elimination of support of Windows XP as of April 8, 2014. Certain Allworx software applications can be installed and used with Windows XP. This bulletin describes Allworx's testing and support policies with certain applications when running on Windows XP after cessation of support from Microsoft.

Impact

Allworx will make every effort to continue to support its applications on Windows XP, however with Microsoft's withdrawal of support for Windows XP there will be a time in the future where it will difficult to resolve open issues with those applications when running on Windows XP. Therefore, Allworx development will cease testing affected applications with Windows XP after 12/31/2014.

Additionally, support for Internet Explorer 8, the highest version available on Windows XP, will not be supported for access to the web interfaces on Server Software Release 8.0, scheduled for release in Q1 2015.
